## Westminster Bridge South: resurfacing works in your area from 23 July

We are planning to carry out resurfacing works on York Road and Addington Street as part of the Westminster Bridge South scheme. As this cannot be completed while the carriageway is being used, I am writing to let you know that a series of temporary road closures will be needed from 23 July.

### Temporary road closures planned in July

The works are planned in phases to keep disruption to a minimum, as outlined in the table below.

Unfortunately, the nature of the works means that some noise will be unavoidable. We are planning to complete the noisiest works by midnight at the latest, and I apologise in advance for the inconvenience.

23 and 24 July	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- The Westminster Bridge Road, Addington Street and Station Approach Road junction will be closed</li><li>- No access to Westminster Bridge Road or Lambeth Palace Road from York Road / Waterloo IMAX Roundabout</li><li>- No access to Station Approach Road from Westminster Bridge Road or York Road / Waterloo IMAX Roundabout</li><li>- No access between Westminster Bridge Road and Westminster Bridge</li></ul>	21:00 each night to 05:00 the following morning
25 July	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- No access to Westminster Bridge Road, Station Approach Road or Lambeth Palace Road from York Road / Waterloo IMAX Roundabout</li></ul>	
26 July	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- No access to York Road / Waterloo IMAX Roundabout from Westminster Bridge Road or Lambeth Palace Road</li><li>- The York Road Slip Road will be closed</li></ul>	

Temporary traffic diversions will be clearly signed, but please plan ahead, allow more time and use alternative routes, where possible. Vehicle access will be maintained for properties on York Road.

Please note that while every effort will be made to complete the works as planned, poor weather conditions may result in the works and associated road closures being rescheduled at short notice. ### Bus passengers

Bus routes 12, 53, 76, 77, 148, 159, 211, 341, 381, 453, 507, N109, N155, N381 and C10 will be temporarily diverted at times during the works. ### Pedestrians

Footways and pedestrian crossings will remain open wherever possible, although some temporary closures or diversions may apply. These will be clearly signed, while pedestrian access to properties will not be affected.
